Provide a narrative on progress toward meeting the goals outlined above.

Jalen Rose Leadership Academy tests scholars throughout the year on PSAT and SAT, including a baseline and two interim assessments. To help achieve our growth goals, we have put in place intervention services for both ELA and math. We have also tailored the curriculum with standards pacing so that teachers are teaching concepts and strategies that align directly with the PSAT and SAT.

**Winter Update:** While JRLA did not meet a 5% increase in proficiency for both ELA and math on the mid-year assessment, they did exceed the 5% increase in ELA with having a 7.7% increase in proficient scholars, and were only .07% away from meeting the mid-year math goal, with having a 4.3% increase in proficient scholars. In addition to proficiency, JRLA has seen an increase in average overall scores, average ELA scores, and average math scores:

**11th Grade:** 5% increase in overall scores, 7% increase in ELA scores, 4% increase in math scores **10th Grade:** 10% increase in overall scores, 12% increase in ELA scores, 9% increase in math scores **9th Grade:** 1% increase in overall scores, 4% increase in ELA scores, -3% (decrease) in math scores
